

DPLA SCHOOL UNIFORMS

DP Learning Academy requires all students to wear school uniforms. Uniforms must be in good condition with no major holes, or rips and no large stains.

Uniforms consist of the following colors: dark blue, medium blue, light blue, burgundy, tan, white, or black.

TOPS Must be in one of the school colors and either polo style collar or a plain t-shirt with no writing or graphics. Tops must fit well and not be too baggy, too tight or show the student's stomach or midriff.

PANTS Must be in one of the school colors excluding white. Pants cannot be jean material, but can be cotton pants. Pants may not be below the waist or too baggy and must not be skin tight or "skinny" pants. Undergarments must not be seen when sitting, playing or bending over.

GIRLS SKIRTS Must be in one of the school colors. Skirts must be "skorts" (shorts attached) or have shorts underneath. Length of skirt must be long enough that, with student's hands at their sides, bottom of the skirt is down to the fingertips. Leggings may also be worn underneath skirts. Undergarments must not be seen when sitting, playing or bending over.

SHORTS Must be in one of the school colors. Shorts must be long enough that, with student's hands at their sides, bottom of the shorts must be long enough that, with students hands at their sides, bottom of the shorts are down to the fingertips. Undergarments must not be seen when sitting, playing or bending over.

SHOES Students shoes must be appropriate for academics as well as play. No open toed shoes of any kind are allowed. If your student wears shoes that are not appropriate for PE class, they must bring an extra pair of shoes with them.

- Any school shirt (bought from the school office) may be worn on any day of the week as part of the uniform.
- Students may not wear all black as part of their uniform. Black shirts, pants, skirts or shorts are allowed as long as they are paired with another color.
- No specific brand is required by DP Learning Academy.

GENTLY USED UNIFORMS

The DPLA school office does its best to keep a variety of gently used uniforms. Items are \$1 each. If you have uniform items that your student no longer uses and the uniforms are gently used, you may donate them for other families. Please visit the school office to purchase gently used uniforms or to donate.

REPLACEMENT CLOTHING

Should your student have an accident while at school and need replacement clothing the office will do their best to supply temporary clothing. The temporary clothing is for loan and must be returned clean or you will be billed \$1 per item. Please contact your teacher as to whether you can keep an extra change of clothing in the classroom for such occasions.
