

PARENT AGREEMENT

Please read the following agreement carefully. Your signature(s) below indicate that you have read, understand, and agree with the policies, mission, purpose and philosophy of the Dwelling Place Christian School.

1. I/We have investigated the policies, procedures, vision, purpose, philosophy and statement of faith of the learning environment at Dwelling Place Christian School (hereafter referred to as DPCS). I have read the parent/student handbook, agree with, and commit to cooperate and uphold all items as outlined in the document.
2. We will pay all tuition, registration/testing fees and any other fees that may be incurred as established by the school. We will pay all costs incurred by the school for collection of fees should such actions become necessary. We will notify the school in a timely manner should unforeseen circumstances arise where tuition can not be paid as agreed. We will agree to modified terms of payment as agreed to with school administration. We have read and understand the financial obligation and payment schedule.
3. We are aware that DPCS is a Bible centered, spirit filled learning environment and support that instruction.
4. As parents/guardians, we agree to support and continue spiritual training of our student(s) at home.
5. We understand the obligation to be actively involved in the education of our child. We agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of the school by encouraging our child's study habits and ensuring that our child completes all homework and other assigned projects.
6. We will faithfully support the school through our prayers and positive attitudes. We will share any complaints only with the parties involved.
7. We understand that DPCS does not tolerate obscenity, profanity, defamation of God's Word, disrespect toward staff members, fellow students, or school policies by DPCS students. We commit to setting the same example when we are on campus.
8. We understand that if, for any reason, our child does not respond favorably to the school, we will do everything in our power to cooperate with the school to help our child make the necessary adjustments. If these adjustments cannot be made, we then agree to withdraw our child at the school's request in order to help them be successful in a different learning environment.
9. If any of the information in the student's admission application is found to be intentionally untrue, DPCS reserves the right not to enroll the student or to dismiss the student from school.
10. We agree to make every effort to have our student to school on time. Excessive tardiness and absences may result in suspension and possibly removal from DPCS.
11. We agree that if for any reason there is a conflict with the teaching method of our child's teacher or disagreement with curriculum being taught, we will meet with the teacher and school administrator to discuss the issue and work with the school to resolve the problem to help our student achieve success.
12. If there is reason to believe that a student is in danger or they themselves are a threat to another, administration shall notify the police so that the student might receive appropriate outside treatment and assessment. If the student's parents or legal guardian cannot be reached, this step can be taken without their permission. Administration may disclose personally identifiable information from the student's records to the appropriate party.
13. I/We understand and agree that continued enrollment and re-enrollment of my child at DPCS is dependent on my parental support of the school, its staff and its policies.

I/we do hereby agree and understand that DPCS and the Dwelling Place City Church are not responsible and therefore not liable in any manner for lost, missing, stolen or damaged personal electronic items that students bring to campus, including but not limited to items such as MP3 players, iPods, laptop computers, electronic notebooks, cell phones, CD players, handheld video games or any such electronic device. Any student bringing such items to school or carrying them on school premises whether visible or not, does so at his/her own personal risk. No monies shall be paid to any student or parent making a claim for the loss or damage of such items.
15. I have read and understand the non-discrimination policy set forth in the parent-student handbook.
16. I/We understand that every effort will be made to protect and safeguard all students. Therefore, I/We agreed not to hold DPCS or Dwelling Place City Church liable for any illness or mishap that may occur to our child. I/We will cooperate with the discipline policies as set forth by DPCS.
